Bridge to Peace is a faith-based approach to a better understanding of Post-Traumatic Stress (PTS), Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD) and Traumatic Brain Injury (TBI). The goal of this ministry is to provide tools, strategies, structure and support that can aid both the families and the individuals suffering with the effects of these injuries.

Facing Trauma Related Stress is all too often a lonely struggle. The Church should be leading the way in a careful handling of each individual and family that is struggling with these injuries.

We believe that peace and hope for those suffering these effects <u>is</u> <u>not found</u> in solving their suffering, but that it <u>is found</u> in learning to entrust themselves to God in the midst of their suffering, believing that somehow, He will work all things for their good!
