The Development of a Church Wide Awareness Concerning the Issues of Mental Illness, and 4. Cultivating a Spirit of Inclusiveness in The Life of the Church.

The goal of this ministry is to provide tools, strategies, structure and support that can aid both the families and the individuals suffering with the effects of these injuries.

Facing Trauma Related Stress is all too often a lonely struggle. The Church should be leading the way in a careful handling of each individual and family that is struggling with these injuries.
