Bridges of Hope

Bridges of Hope is a faith-based approach to better understanding mental illness. It helps educate family members, caregivers and the body of Christ, enabling them to provide support for those diagnosed with a mental illness as well as those affected by the mental illness.

The Bridges Ministry is built upon four key cornerstones: 1. The Bridges of Hope Basic Course, 2. The Bridges of Hope Support Group Meetings, 3. The Development of a Church Wide Awareness Concerning the Issues of Mental Illness, and 4. Cultivating a Spirit of Inclusiveness in The Life of the Church.

We are committed to the belief that the best cannot be achieved without Spiritual Health and that Spiritual Health is available to anyone who will listen to and apply the Word of God to their life.

Bridge to Peace is a faith-based approach to a better understanding of Post-Traumatic Stress (PTS), Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD) and Traumatic Brain Injury (TBI). The goal of this ministry is to provide tools, strategies, structure and support that can aid both the families and the individuals suffering with the effects of these injuries.

Facing Trauma Related Stress is all too often a lonely struggle. The Church should be leading the way in a careful handling of each individual and family that is struggling with these injuries.

We believe that peace and hope for those suffering these effects **is not found** in solving their suffering, but that it **is found** in learning to entrust themselves to God in the midst of their suffering, believing that somehow, He will work all things for their good!
