This morning our focus will be on the 2^{sd} commandment. **Exodus 20:4-5**

An idol is anything that takes the place that rightly belongs to God.

Simply put, an idol is anything I value more than I value God.

What does the Lord say about these idols? **Deuteronomy 4:15b-16a (NIV)**

I. IDOLS WILL DISAPOINT YOU.

Idols always promise more than they can deliver. Jeremiah 10:14

Have you ever bought anything that was <u>nothing but a disappointment</u> after you got it? **HELLO!**

Idols will always disappoint you. Habakkuk 2:18

II. IDOLS WILL DISTRACT YOU.

Whenever you love ANYTHING more than you love God, that idol will begin to distract you from your relationship with God.

III. IDOLS WILL DESTROY YOU.

Is there anything that's holding you back from being all that God wants you to be? That is an idol.

We are to worship God and God ALONE.

Worship means I humble myself and surrender myself to Him and Him alone.

The question we must each ask ourselves is this.

Have I allowed anything to take the place that rightly belongs only to God? 1 John 5:21

IT PROVIDES GROWTH.
