Our Invitation 2 Cor.6:1-13

God's grace is the central theme of Scripture.

It is God Surrendering His Son to bring man into a relationship with Himself.

A relationship not based on the efforts of man, but on the grace of God.

God's grace truly is the most phenomenal theme of Scripture.

Be it: SAVING GRACE - SUSTAINING GRACE. - SANCTIFYING GRACE.

Our text this morning is found in the 2 Corinthians the 6th chapter.

Paul is writing to people who have criticized him almost unmercifully.

They question his authenticity and his sincerity.

In the midst of this he writes to them about grace.

He knows that if they ever change it will be God's grace that affected that change.

Titus 2:11-14

Paul's invitation to them is centered on grace.

Do you want to see change in someone's life? PERHAPS YOURS;

Grace is the answer! Look at what Paul writes to them.

I. DON'T IGNORE GOD'S GRACE. 2 Corinthians 6:1,2

Don't ignore God's grace.

What if Peter had ignored His grace after his denial of Jesus?

Ephesians 4:1-3

Walk worthy of the calling by which you have been called.

Romans 12:1, 2

II. DON'T PUT OFF GOD'S GRACE. 2 Corinthians 6:3-13

Paul is saying -Don't Procrastinate.

Surrender your pride and your will and humble yourself before God.

2 Corinthians 6:3-10 The Message

What are you waiting for?

One day you will no longer have an opportunity to respond to God's Grace.

III. ENTER INTO THIS GRACE FILLED LIFE 2 Corinthians 6:11-13

Experience the freedom of living in a relationship with God;

that is not filled with fear and condemnation.

Open up your lives. Live openly and expansively!

Listen to the words of Jesus. **Revelation 3:20-21**

Open the door of your heart!

IV. DON'T WALK AWAY FROM GOD'S GRACE. 2 Corinthians 6:14-18

Grace is a powerful statement of God's love and will for us.

Why would we waste it?

Why would we put off embracing it?

Why not enter it?

For your sake don't walk away from it.
