Note who criticizes! John specifically mentions Judas's indignation.

Mary acted while she still could. Mark. 14:8

On that first Easter morning a small band of women went to the tomb to anoint the body of Jesus. –

But He wasn't there.

It was too late. <u>Do what you can – when you can.</u>

Mary gave her best.

Jesus said that what she did would be preached as a memorial to her. Mark 14:9

- 5. Be an example to other believers. 1 Timothy 4:12

III. DO WHAT YOU CAN TO BUILD UP THE BODY OF CHRIST. Ephesians 4:11-16

- 1. Build up the body through teaching!
- 2. Build up the body through love!
- 3. Build up the body through evangelism.
