It is a basic part of life and as time passes

Ecclesiastes 3:1-8

I. CHANGE IS A REALITY OF LIFE

Life is in a constant state of change.

Life is like a river continually flowing and never the same twice.

A. God Never Changes

Malachi 3:6a

B. The Word of God is faithful and true.

Revelation 22:6

C. The character of Jesus never changes!

When everything else in life falls apart this is the one thing you can count on. Jesus is the same yesterday today and forever.

Jesus cared enough to call you to salvation; He still cares about you today.

D. The love of Jesus never changes!

Jesus loved you enough to die in your place.

He loved you that much then and His love for you never changed.

E. The presence of Jesus never changes!

He will never leave you or forsake you. Jesus never changes!

III. STANDING FIRM IN CRUCIBLE OF CHANGE

Standing firm through a severe, searching test or trial REQUIRES TRUST IN GOD. Proverbs 3:5, 6; Psalm 56:4; Isaiah 12:2; Isaiah 26:3, 4; John 14:1; Romans 15:13; 1 Peter 4:19

But listen to what God says:

Jeremiah 29:11-13
