1. God's power to salvation. **Romans 1:16**  
*It is the power of God at work, saving everyone who believes*
2. It moves men.  
**1 Thessalonians 1:5**  
No one remains neutral when they hear the gospel.

1. That we come to Him. **Matthew 11:28-30**
2. That we go for Him. **Matthew 28:18-20**
3. That we proclaim Him. **Matthew 10:7**  
In the lives we live, our conversations, our activities. **1 Corinthians 10:31**

1. They are great and precious. **2 Peter 1:4**
2. Grace sufficient for every situation. **2 Corinthians 12:8-10**  
Divine care and comfort – All our needs –  
Divine companionship – Remission of sins.
3. Adoption into God's family **Galatians 4:5**
4. Eternal life. **John 3:16; John 10:27-30**
5. The second coming of Christ.
6. Our Personal Resurrection- to be with Christ forever...
