John 20:1-10

Early that morning, Mary came to the tomb, found the stone rolled away, and ran to find Simon Peter.

While Peter and the other disciple went into the tomb, Mary stood outside.

When the two disciples left to return home, Mary stooped and looked in.

John 20:11-18

Seeing Jesus did many things for Mary at that very moment.

He had changed her life already, but she was never the same after encountering The Risen Lord.

Let's consider "What The Risen Savior Will Do For Us"

I. THE RISEN SAVIOR WILL CALL OUR NAME - v16 "Mary!" Jesus said."

Jesus had changed Mary's life; He was her deliverer and she was a devoted follower!

She had followed Jesus all the way Cross, and beyond!

Jesus had changed her life when He called her name and delivered her from her demons.

Now, Jesus called her name here at the tomb. And her life would never be the same!

II. THE RISEN SAVIOR WILL CALM OUR FEARS - v13

Mary was overwhelmed with sorrow, sadness and fear.

People today live lives filled with fear:

o Fear of death o Fear of judgment o Fear of eternity

Hebrews 9:27

Jesus Conquered death, judgment, and condemnation.

1 Corinthians 15:20

Because of HIS VICTORY, Jesus can help us! ... He can CALM OUR FEARS!

John 10:10

III. THE RISEN SAVIOR WILL COMFORT OUR SORROWS - v15

Mary was crying because she thought someone had stolen her Master's body.

Every person here has troubles!

Whatever the issue is that you are facingIT IS NOT TOO BIG FOR GOD!

If you give God a chance you will see, (like Mary did) that God is STILL IN CONTROL

IV. THE RISEN SAVIOR WILL VONWURT OUT DOUBT. v16

Mary was focused completely on the present.

Many times we become so focused and consumed with the problems of today that we forget about the promises of God?

Jesus can remove our doubt.

How did He remove Mary's doubt? HE SIMPLY CALLED HER NAME!
