- Changing Direction.

II. WE NEED A NEW GAME PLAN

Proverbs 3:5-7 - Hebrews 11:6

A fresh start without a new game plan always produces the same old results.

God's ways are often counter intuitive. [they don't fit human logic.

The Big Decision: Do I trust God's advice or my best judgment?

III. WE NEED POWER TO KEEP GOING

Philippians 2:13 - Ephesians 1:18-20 - Philippians 1:6

A fresh start without power to keep going is just a good intention.

When Jesus died the disciples were overcome with defeat.

But 3 days later, they realized Jesus is victorious over death.

Today, we celebrate the glorious truth that Jesus Christ arose from the dead.

The victory that God has purchased for us still applies,

You don't have to feel defeated...

you can get back up and have a clean slate!

Just don't fail to begin today with A NEW BEGINNING.
