A TRULY REMARKABLE CONVERT

There are a number of remarkable conversions in the Bible. But perhaps, the most remarkable conversion in the Bible was The Thief on The Cross. **Luke 23:32-43**

What makes this conversion so remarkable?

I. A REMARKABLE PROPHECY WAS FULFILLED Luke 23:32

These were not just ordinary thieves.

Historians declare crucifixion was reserved for the most incorrigible criminals.

Isaiah 53:9

All three parts of this verse were fulfilled on the cross between these two criminals.

II. THE REMARKABLE PRAYER HE PRAYED. Luke 23:40-42

Here we find <u>four prerequisites</u> to having sins forgiven by Christ.

- 1. He recognized His guilt **before a holy God**.
- 2. He recognized that he deserved God's judgment.
- 3. He proclaimed the righteousness of Christ.
- 4. His exercised faith in Jesus.

How was he saved?—<u>By FAITH alone</u>, <u>plus nothing</u>, and <u>minus nothing</u>. He just <u>looked to the Crucified Savior</u> and asked Him to let him into His kingdom.

III. THE REMARKABLE PROMISE OF JESUS. Luke 23:43

"I assure you, today you will be with me in paradise."

WHAT A PROMISE!

- "You've lived your whole life in sin—but today you'll be with me in paradise!"
- "You've done wicked, vile, evil things—but today you'll be with me in paradise!"
- "You've wasted a life, squandered it—but today you'll be with me in paradise!"
- "You've embarrassed your parents, dishonored God, tarnished the family name, shamed to your village—but today you'll join me in paradise!"

Wow!—What a God! What grace! What mercy! What love!
