## Exodus 20:16 (TLB)

Lying is epidemic in American culture. -- <u>We see it everywhere</u>. Is it possible to be consistently honest in a dishonest world? <u>God will enable us to live the life He has called us to live</u>.

How can we live a life of honesty?

I. BY TELLING THE COMPLETE TRUTH.
Even society recognizes this truth.
The oath of a witness in the Court of Law.
II. BY TELLING THE TRUTH CONSISTIENTLY. Ephesians 4:15
Honesty is to be a lifestyle. It is about being like Christ.
Honesty has to be consistent if we are to be like Christ. <b>Proverbs 11:3</b>
III. BY TELLING THE TRUTH LOVINGLY. Ephesians 4:15
Speak the truth in a spirit of love.
People perceive truth without love as an attack.
The key to speaking the truth in a spirit of love has to do with motivation.
If I'm doing it for their benefit, then that's speaking the truth in love.
IV. BY TELLING THE TURTH TACTFULLY. Proverbs 12:18
Contemplate before you communicate.
Put your mind in gear before you put your mouth in gear. Matthew 12:34b (NIV)
The real problem in all of this is not our mouth.
The real problem is our heart. Matthew 15:19 (NLT)
V. DISHONESTY IS A SYMPTOM OF A DEEPER PROBLEM
1. Resentment:
Sometimes people lie out of hatred, spite, or to get revenge.
2. Fear:
Sometimes people lie in an attempt to escape consequences.
3. Insecurity:
Sometimes people lie in an attempt to cover up low self-esteem.
4. Selfishness:
Sometimes people lie to get what they want when they want it.
Psalm 34:12-13 (TEV)
VI. LYING IS A MATTER OF THE HEART.
The good news is that Jesus specializes in heart transplants.
The closer you get to Jesus Christ the more:
you're going to love the truth, speak the truth, and live the truth.
Admit it:
Sometimes I lie. Sometimes I exaggerate. Sometimes I tell half-truths.
Ask Christ to forgive you and give you the power to change.
Ask Him to cleanse and purify your heart. <b>1 John 1:9 (NLT)</b>
Will you give Christ full control of your heart.
