Last week, we considered the 1st essential discipline that is required for success.

You must have the same attitude that Christ Jesus had. Philippians 2:5

Today we will consider the 2^{sd} essential discipline that is required for success.

Timothy was a "man of God"

Paul tells Timothy "Keep a close watch on yourself" 1 Timothy 4:16

In 1 Timothy 6:11-21 Paul gives Timothy four admonitions.

If followed they will insure Timothy will be an effective agent of change!

I. RUN FROM EVIL 1 Timothy 6:11a

There are times when fleeing is a mark of wisdom and a means of victory.

The Greek word interpreted "flee" or "run" means,

separating himself ...from the sinsof the false teachers.

The servant of God should take a stand against false doctrine and godless practices and separate themselves from them.

II. PURSUE RIGHTEOUSNESS AND A GODLY LIFE 1 Timothy 6:11b

It means to run after; to run swiftly after; to hotly pursue; to seek eagerly and earnestly.

There are six things we are to hotly pursue:

<u>Righteousness A godly life Faith Love Perseverance Gentleness</u>
Ask yourself.... "Are these attributes of God flowing through my life?"

I. FIGHT THE GOOD FIGHT FOR THE TRUE FATIH 1 Timothy 6:12-14

The verb means "Keep on fighting!"

The true nature of the Christian life is that it is a battleground! *Ephesians 6:11, 12* We are called to strive and agonize for the prize. *2 Timothy 4:6, 7*

IV. GUARD WHAT GOD HAS ENTRUSTED TO YOU 1 Timothy 6:20, 21

It was Timothy's responsibility.... to guard what God had entrusted to him and then pass it along to others. 2 *Timothy 2:1*, 2

We to are stewards of the doctrines of the faith!
