II. THE MAN IN THE MIRROR SHOULD BE A MAN OF CHARACTER.

A. The man of character is the same in the world as he is with God's people.

B. The man of character should be consistent.

C. There is a Decisive Difference between Good character and Godly character.

1 Timothy 6:11

1. A good man is known for what he gives up.

2. A Godly man is known for what he takes up.

He gives up unholy vices.

He takes up a pursuit of God's character.

III. THE MAN IN THE MIRROR SHOULD LEAVE A CHRIST-LIKE EXAMPLE.
