The Call to Repentance

- A. Jesus began his teaching ministry with this bold proclamation. Matthew 4:17 He commands repentance as a requirement for entrance into His kingdom.
- B. Jesus declared that His ministry was to call sinners to repentance. Luke 5:32
- C. Repentance is the keynote theme of New Testament preaching:

I. WHAT REPENTANCE IS NOT.

- A. <u>Conviction of sin is not repentance</u>.
 Conviction opens the door to repentance, but a person can be deeply convicted and still not repent. Acts 24:24-25
- B. <u>Sorrow for sin is not repentance.</u>
 Repentance includes sorrow and remorse,
 but it is possible to be sorry for sin and still not repent. 2 Corinthians 7:9
- C. <u>Hatred of sin is not repentance</u>. Repentance includes this, but it is possible to hate sin and yet not to turn from it.
- D. <u>Promising to be better is not repentance</u>.
 - Consider the Prodigal son. Luke 15:18 19

By him simply saying that he'd return didn't indicate repentance. But that by no means is the end of his story. Luke 15:20a

II. WHAT TRUE REPENTANCE RESULTS IN.

A. <u>True repentance results in a change of mind.</u>

The change of mind involves an entirely new attitude towards God, towards sin and towards self. Matthew 21:28-29

- B. <u>True repentance results in a change of feeling</u>. After conversion, Saul was overwhelmed with remorse at the way he had treated the Lord Jesus.
- C. <u>True repentance results in a change of purpose.</u> Acts 9:6 Paul did a 180.
- D. True repentance results in change of conduct. Consider Zacchaeus.
- III. TRUE REPENTANCE IS A DIVINE GIFT.
 - A. True repentance is only possible because of God's grace.
 - No one can repent unless God grants repentance. Acts 5:31; Acts 11:18
 - B. The goodness of God leads to True repentance. Romans 2:4

IV. REPENTANCE IS ONE OF THREE ESSENTIAL ELEMENTS IN SALVATION.

- 1. The conviction of the Holy Spirit. John 16:8-11
- 2. Saving faith, not just believing **Romans 10:9,10**
- 3. True repentance; agreeing with God about your sin. 1 Corinthians 6:9-11

V. WHEN IS THE BEST TIME TO REPENT?

Right now. Isaiah 1:18; 2 Peter 3:9

The Lord is patiently waiting for you.

He doesn't want anyone to perish, but everyone to come to repentance."
