A LIFE WORTH FOLLOWING 2 Corinthians 5:20

Last week we saw that as Ambassadors of Christ, our call to Action is to be: A PERSON WORTH FOLLOWING!

Have you ever said to a young Christian,

"If you want to know what Christianity is like? Watch me!"

That is a major theme expressed numerous times in Paul's letters.

1 Cor. 11:1 "Imitate me, just as I imitate Christ."

That's a bold statement!

Some might even claim that Paul is being arrogant here.

They argue:

Why wouldn't Paul just say follow Christ?

I. PAUL ACKNOWLEDGED THAT HE WAS AN AMBASSADOR OF CHRIST.

He recognized that he was <u>an authorized messenger and representative.</u>
He recognized that <u>God had given him the task of reconciling people to Him</u>.
Galatians 2:20 gives us insight into Paul's thinking.

Galatians 2:20

When Paul is saying follow me, imitate me; he is really saying follow Jesus, imitate Jesus.

II. PAUL RECOGNIZED HIS LIFE WAS A SACRIFICE

"living for Christ" – is to <u>BE A LIVING SACRIFICE!</u> Sacrificing this life for the kingdom.

III. PAUL EMBRACED THE DUTIES OF HIS APPOINTMENT

IV. PAUL WAS FULLY COMMITTED TO CARRYING OUT THE RESPONSIBILITIES OF HIS COMMISSION.
