## Don't Be Troubled. John 14:1-6

Jesus shared these promises on the night he was betrayed and arrested. It is a message from Jesus that takes us <u>from trouble to triumph</u>!

### I. A MESSAGE THAT CALLS US TO PEACE IN TIMES OF PERIL.

- 1. Jesus and the disciples are gathered in the Upper Room.
  - a. They have come to Jerusalem for the Passover.
  - b. It was a pleasant feast, a feast of celebration, of precious fellowship.
- 2. Jesus reveals the tough times that lay ahead.
  - a. Judas will betray Him. John 13:21; John 13:30
  - b. Peter will deny Him. John 13:36-38
- 3. There are tough times ahead for all of us. John 16:33
  - a. Most go through things they didn't THINK THEY WOULD.
  - b. Many go through things they didn't THINK THEY COULD.

### 4. Even then: Don't let your heart be troubled!

WE CAN BE PEACEFUL IN PERILOUS TIMES.

II. A MESSAGE THAT CALLS US TO TRUST IN TIMES OF TROUBLE.

1.TRUST: is a life changing commitment.

### a. To exercise faith is to Trust. Acts 16:30, 31 Amplified Classic

- 2. "Trust in God,"
  - a. Trust that God exists; that He is the Creator.
  - b. Trust that God is in Control.
- 3. "and Trust also in me."
  - a. Trust that Jesus came to save sinners.
  - b. Trust that Jesus died to pay for our sins.
  - c. Act on this trust: Surendar to His Lordship.
  - d. Rest your future in His Hands.

III. A MESSAGE THAT CALLS US TO LOOK BEYOND LIFE'S DIFFICULTIES. John 14:2

1. *There is more than enough room in my Father's home.* 

- a. All trouble here is temporary. 1 Peter 1:6, 7
- b. The best is yet to come.
- c. Heaven awaits all believers. 2 Corinthians 5:6-8
- 2. If this were not so, would I have told you that I am going to prepare a place for you?

Philippians 1:22, 23

- a. What a wonderful place heaven must be! John 14:2
- b. Look beyond your heartaches to heaven. John 14:3
- 3. When everything is ready, I will come and get you,

Are you ready for his return?
