Only when we think can the Holy Spirit illuminate, enlighten, lead, and guide us.

Psalm 1:1-3 NLT

Unless we think and meditate, unless we exercise our mind we will not be blessed or happy.

III. OUR WILL

We exercise our Will by becoming more and more decisive!

- A. True, we must learn to wait on the Lord's clear leadership!
- B. Also true, we must learn to recognize that leadership and decisively follow it!

Philippians 2:13 NLT

IV. OUR MEMORY

2 Peter 3:1, 2 NLT

Our memory needs to be exercised if we are going to be aware of:

- a. Our old lost condition.
- b. Those still in the condition,
- c. the need to be consumed by the passion of pleasing Christ Jesus!!
