- a. Nothing planted, nothing harvested.
- b. Pray – Study – put your heart into serving Christ by serving others.

II. THE LORD REVEALS THE WAY **Philippians 3:12-14**

- a. We need to let go of our past.
 We cannot move beyond our failures when we hang on to them.
- b. We need to focus on our future.
 - (1). God has given us each day,
 so we can seize it and make the most of it for His Glory.
 - (2). We can never find God's best if we give up!

III. THE GOAL CANNOT BE REACHED IF WE GIVE INTO WEARINESS.

Galatians 6:9

- a. Weariness may arise from a number of sources.
 - (1). Physical exhaustion
 - (2). Spiritual exhaustion: worry
- b. Weariness invites failure.
 - (1). We grow weary when the work seems overwhelming.
 - (2). We grow weary when we don't see immediate fruit
 from our labor.

IV. KEYS TO PREVENTING WEARINESS

- a. Keep close to the Master.

- b. Have faith in His promises. **Isaiah 55:11**
 - (1). Perseverance will bring success.
 - (2). Success will inspire courage.
 - (3). Courage will bring victory.
 - (4). Victory will be followed by glory.
