David offers praise for the Lord's goodness.

Here are just a few reasons for purposely and actively Praising the Lord.

I. HE RICHLY GIVES US ALL WE NEED **1 Timothy 6:17**

In the gift of His Son, He pledged Himself to supply all our need.

II. HE FORGIVES ALL OUR SINS **Psalm 103:3a**

Iniquity is a gross injustice or wickedness.

(a violation of right; a wicked act; sin.)

He cannot change its character.

Light can have no fellowship with darkness.

He must either punish iniquity or forgive it.

III. HE HEALS ALL OUR DISEASES **Psalm 103:3b**

Iniquity refers to sinful wicked acts.

Disease refers to the immoral heart that is the force behind the sinful acts.

Every part of man's moral nature is diseased. **Romans 7:18-20**

But His healing power, the blood of Christ, cleanses us from all sin.

IV. HE REDEEMS US FROM DEATH. **Psalm 103:4a**

He not only forgives and heals, but He delivers us from eternal destruction. **John 3:16-21**

V. HE CROWNS US WITH LOVE AND TENDER MERCIES **Psalm 103:4b**

Those who have been healed of all their diseases will be crowned with His love and tender mercies.

Psalm 5:12

VI. HE FILLS OUR LIFE WITH GOOD **Psalm 103:5a**

Only the redeemed, the pure in heart, those saved and healed by the Lord
can be satisfied with the goodness of the Lord. **Psalm 36:8**

VII. HE RENEWS OUR YOUTH **Psalm 103:5b**

Those who are born again have their youth renewed,

because they are a new creation in Christ Jesus. **Isaiah 40:31**
