I. GOD'S PLAN OF REDEMPTION

Romans 3:24

III. THE PERMANENCE OF REDEMPTION **1 Peter 1:22, 23**

The work that Christ's blood does in our lives is an ETERNAL WORK!!

It guarantees us eternal security. **Ephesians 4:30**

Jesus Himself promises security **John 10:28**

IV. THE PROCESS OF REDEMPTION

Before the world began God chose Jesus to be our redeemer. **1 Peter 1:20, 21**

The Greek word for redemption is literally translated "paid in full" **Ephesians 1:7**

All we can do is accept His offer! **John 1:12; John 3:16; John 5:24**

V. THE POSSIBILITY OF REDEMPTION **1 Peter 1:24, 25; 1 Corinthians 1:21**

God is extending an invitation to salvation "through the preaching of the gospel".

Revelation 22:17

God deemed you valuable enough

that He gave His only Son to make way of redemption for you.

He is extending you an offer of redemption right here... right now.
