When was the last time you thanked God for the gift of:

A. Sight:

The beauty of Sunrise or Sunset; the world we live in; the eyes of one you love.

B. **Hearing:**

Think of the blessings of hearing. The beautiful music, voices of friends and loved ones.

C. Taste:

Some can't taste. Thank God for the mercy of giving us taste.

D. Touch:

What if we were unable to touch our spouse?

What about the softness of a baby?

Thank God for the mercy of having a sense of touch.

E. Smell:

How awful it would be to be unable to smell.

What if you couldn't smell a fire burning?

Thank God for smell.

V. THANK GOD FOR EVERY BLESSING (With a heart filled with gratitude!)

James 1:17 All good comes from God.

VI. THE APPEAL

Romans 12:1
