1Cor. 11:27-32

The Question then is.

IS JESUS SATISFIED WITH ME?

We can come to The Lord's Table unworthily in different ways.

- 1. By coming ritualistically, without participating with our minds and hearts.
- 2. By going through the motions without going through any emotions.
- 3. By treating it lightly rather than seriously.
- 4. By holding onto a spirit of bitterness or hatred toward another believer.
- 5. By coming with sin that we are unwilling to repent of.

Matthew 5:23, 24

To come unworthily to The Lord's Table DISHONORS the One in whose honor it is celebrated. *WE MOCK CHRIST WHEN WE COME UNWORTHILY!!*

IS JESUS SATISFIED WITH ME?

<u>Is He Satisfied With My Worship?</u>

- 1. Worshiping the Lord God, should be a happy, joyous experience. Joyful because it is directed solely toward Him.
- 2. Worshiping the Lord God <u>unifies His people</u>.

It is impossible to Worship the Lord while holding onto hostility and alienation.

- 3. Worshiping the Lord God involves <u>submitting to His sovereign authority</u>. Jesus said, "*I have been given all authority in heaven and on earth*".
- 4. Worshiping the Lord God includes "making a joyful noise".

Joyful singing is based on the awareness that God is worthy of our worship.

5. Worshiping The Lord <u>includes expressing thanks by giving</u>.

The word "thanksgiving" literally means "extending the hands," as in offering praise, adoration, and service.

- 5. Do I walk circumspectly in the world? **Ephesians 5:15, 16**

- 1. Have I proclaimed Jesus in my daily walk?
- 2. Have I been instrumental in building up another?
- 3. Am I living my life in Vain?

We need to pray the prayer of David. **Psalm 51:10-12** When we examine ourselves, it will make us fall on our knees.
