Are You Ready for Christmas?

The only way to ensure you are ready for Christmas is to be ready for His Return.

Luke 12:40

People who are ready for their Lord's return are:

I. SINCERE, NOT HYPOCRITICAL LUKE 12:1-3

- 1. Trying to appear holy when their heart is far from God.
- 2. Their selfishness would act like yeast, and soon:
 - a. they would expose themselves for what they really were
 - b. power- hungry impostors, not devoted religious leaders.
- 3. Each of us must resist the temptation to settle for:
 - a. the appearance of respectability
 - b. when our hearts are far from God

II. READY TO WITNESS, NOT FEARFUL Luke 12:4-9

- 1. Too often we cling to peace and comfort, even at the cost of our walk with God!
- 2. We deny Jesus when we:
 - a. are silent about our relationship with God
 - b. Blend into society, and
 - c. accept our culture's non-Christian values.

3. We acknowledge him when we

- a. live a moral, upright, Christ-honoring life
- b. look for opportunities to share our faith with others
- c. use our life and resources to carry out his desires rather than your own.

III. TRUSTING, NOT WORRIED Luke 12:22-26

- 1. Jesus commands us not to worry!
- 2. Only faith can free us from anxiety
- 3. Worry is pointless because it can't fill any of our needs!
- 4. Worry is foolish because the Father loves us and knows what we need.
- 5. He has promised to meet our need!

IV. GENEROUS, NOT GREEDY Luke 12:34

- 1. Where do you put your time, money, and energy?
- 2. What do you think about most?

VI. LOYAL TO TEIR COMMITMENT, NOT SELF-SERVING Matthew 24:42-44

- 1. Recognizing your fault and changing your ways are two different things.
 - a. Recognizing your sin leads to confession! [Admittance of guilt]
 - b. Repentance leads to changing your ways! [A Committed decision that is carried out!]
- 2. Repentance is a daily activity. [Required daily because we sin daily!]
 - "A Christian is not one who never goes wrong, but one who is enabled to repent and begin over again after each stumble-because of the inner working of Christ."

V. DILIGENT, NOT LAZY Luke 12:35-38

- 1. Diligence requires discipline.
- 2. Only those who endure till the end will be rewarded.
